1 AN ACT concerning regulation of drones; dealing with private property 2 rights.

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4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) A person wrongfully occupies real property and is 6 liable for damages, who, without express permission of the person or 7 entity with the legal authority to grant access to the real property or 8 otherwise without legal authority, operates an unmanned aircraft or 9 unmanned aircraft system less than 350 feet above ground level within the 10 airspace overlaying the real property.

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(b) For purposes of this act:

(1) "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft that is operated without thepossibility of direct human intervention from within or on the aircraft.

(2) "Unmanned aircraft system" means an unmanned aircraft and
associated elements, including communication links and the components
that control the unmanned aircraft, that are required for the pilot in
command to operate safely and efficiently in the national airspace system.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall not be construed to impair or limit any lawful 19 activities of law enforcement personnel or employees of governmental 20 agencies or other public or private entities that may have the right to enter 21 land by operating an unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system 22 within the airspace overlaying the real property of another.

Sec. 3. (a) The owner, tenant, occupant, invitee or licensee of privately owned real property shall have a civil cause of action for compensatory damages for violations of this act and may seek injunctive relief to prevent future violations of this act against a person, state agency or political subdivision. Attorney fees shall be awarded to the plaintiff if the plaintiff is the prevailing party. Punitive damages may also be recovered in the appropriate case.

30 (b) Nothing in this section is intended to limit the rights and defenses
31 available at common law under a claim of liability for wrongful
32 occupation of real property.

33 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its34 publication in the statute book.
