AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; eliminating medical assistance coverage for elective induced labor prior to 39 weeks of pregnancy.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) As used in this section:
- (1) "Elective procedure" means a medical procedure or operation not medically indicated for the health of the pregnant woman or the unborn child.
- (2) "Medical assistance" means the Kansas program of medical assistance established by K.S.A. 39-709, and amendments thereto.
- (b) Medical assistance coverage shall not be provided for any elective procedure to induce labor and delivery for a pregnant woman prior to 39 weeks of pregnancy.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
