AN ACT concerning propositions to amend the constitution; relating to 1 2 publication thereof; amending K.S.A. 64-103 and repealing the existing 3 section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 64-103 is hereby amended to read as follows: 64-7 103. (a) All acts of the legislature which shall provide for their taking 8 effect on publication in any newspaper or in the Kansas register shall be 9 published in the Kansas register, which shall be deemed the official publication. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, all 10 proclamations, orders, notices and advertisements authorized by any state 11 12 officer shall be printed and published in the Kansas register. Payment for 13 such publication shall be made by the state at the rates prescribed by law. 14 The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to: (1) Resolutions 15 making propositions to amend the constitution; or (2) proclamations issued 16 by the governor which are not required by law to be issued by the 17 governor. All proclamations issued by the governor which are not 18 published in the Kansas register shall be published on the official Kansas 19 internet website.

20 (b) For the purpose of informing the electors of the propositions to be 21 voted on at the election thereon, the secretary of state shall-eause publish 22 resolutions making propositions to amend the constitution to be published 23 in one newspaper in each county of the state where a newspaper is 24 published, once each week for three consecutive weeks in the 14 days 25 immediately preceding the election at which the proposition is to be 26 submitted. The secretary of state shall also publish such resolutions on the 27 official websites of the secretary of state and the state of Kansas for a 28 period commencing 30 days after final adoption by both houses of the 29 legislature through the date of the election at which the proposition is to 30 be submitted. All costs associated with this subsection shall be paid from 31 the state general fund. 32

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 64-103 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 34 publication in the statute book.
