Uniform Controlled Substances Act—Adding and Rescheduling Certain Drugs or Drug Classes to Schedules of Controlled Substances; HB 2275

HB 2275 amends the statutes regulating controlled substances to add several additional drugs or drug classes to the schedules. Specifically, the bill adds a hallucinogenic drug and a cannibinoid to schedule I, reschedules two hydrocodone drugs from schedule III to schedule II, adds perampanel to schedule III, and adds three drugs to schedule IV. The bill also corrects or standardizes spellings or descriptions of several substances.
