## SESSION OF 2015

### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2090

#### As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

#### Brief\*

HB 2090 would repeal the requirement for each city, county, township, school district, community college, or technical college to file an annual report with the Division of Vehicles identifying the vehicles with permanent registration that governmental entity owns or leases.

# Background

The bill was requested by the Division of Vehicles, and the Division's Manager of Titles and Registration provided proponent testimony in the House Committee on Transportation. He stated the annual report is no longer needed because the current vehicle registration system identifies each of the vehicles. No other testimony was offered.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, the Department of Revenue indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect.
