SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2151

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

Sub. for HB 2151 would amend the law concerning grand juries summoned by petition, commonly referred to as a citizens grand jury. The bill would allow the person who filed the petition and that person's attorney to witness the instructions given to the grand jury, after it is summoned but prior to beginning deliberations, regarding its conduct and deliberations.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the Kansas Register.

Background

HB 2151, as introduced, would have added new sections of the law concerning workplace bullying in State agencies. After a hearing on the original bill, the House Judiciary Committee agreed to strike the contents and replace them with the contents of 2015 HB 2221.

In the Senate Judiciary Committee hearing, representatives of American Family Action of Kansas and Missouri and Kansans for Life appeared in support of the bill. A representative of the Kansas County and District Attorneys Association offered written testimony opposing the bill. No neutral testimony was provided.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to make it effective upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

HB 2221

In the House Judiciary Committee, a representative of the American Family Association appeared in support of the bill. No opponent or neutral testimony was provided.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect on the revenues or expenditures of the Judicial Branch.
