SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2662

As Amended by House Committee on
Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2662 would authorize expenditures from existing resources, including the State General Fund and the Motor Vehicle Tax Refund Fund, and new State General Fund expenditures for the payment of specific claims against the State of Kansas. Agencies affected by the bill are the Department of Corrections, Lansing Correctional Facility, Hutchinson Correctional Facility, El Dorado Correctional Facility, Larned State Hospital, Adjutant General's Department, and Department of Revenue. The bill also would reimburse McPherson and Butler counties for legal costs incurred for sexually violent predator proceedings.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Joint Committee on Special Claims Against the State. Representative Todd, Chairperson of the Joint Committee, provided neutral testimony on the bill. The House Committee on Appropriations amended the bill to strike a claim of \$94.60 that Hutchinson Correctional Facility would have been directed to pay from existing resources. (The claimant decided not to pursue the claim).

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget on the bill, as introduced, notes the bill would authorize expenditures from all funding sources totaling \$96,355.69, including \$73,411.85 from the State General Fund, in FY 2016. As amended, the bill would authorize expenditures from all funding sources totaling \$96,261.09, including \$73,317.25 from the State General Fund. Of the State General Fund amount, \$61,418.22 would be newly appropriated, and \$11,899.03 would be paid from existing funds.
