UPDATED SESSION OF 2015

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 11

As Recommended by House Committee on Appropriations

Brief*

House Sub. for SB 11 would direct the Secretary of Administration to designate all state employees as essential for the purposes of Kansas Administrative Regulation 1-14-11(a) from June 5, 2015, until *sine die* for the 2015 legislative session. Essential employees are not subject to either emergency or administrative furlough.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the Kansas Register.

Background

SB 11, as introduced, would establish the Scrap Metal Theft Reduction Act by adding law and amending existing law related to scrap metal dealer registration and scrap metal sales. Additionally, the bill would amend certain criminal provisions related to scrap metal theft. Provisions on this topic were passed in the Conference Committee Report on HB 2048.

The House Appropriations Committee removed the contents of SB 11, inserted provisions related to the categorization of state employees, and recommended the substitute bill. There was no testimony on the substitute bill.

A fiscal note was not available on the substitute bill.
