SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 248

As Amended by House Committee on Appropriations

Brief*

SB 248, as amended, would remove the authorization for the Chief Administrative Officer at the Kansas State Hospitals to establish key deposit funds to retain moneys from Kansas state employees provided as security deposits for keys to the state facilities.

Background

The Director of Legislative and Public Affairs for the Department of Administration testified in support of the bill at the hearings in the Senate Committee on Ways and Means during the 2015 Legislative Session and the House Committee on Appropriations during the 2016 Legislative Session. The Director indicated the bill was the product of the Office of the Repealer and that state hospital officials contacted said these security deposit funds for keys were no longer utilized. There was no other testimony on the bill.

The House Appropriations Committee amended the bill to correct dates to reflect the current year.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
