SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 39

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

SB 39 would make technical amendments to update statutory and agency references related to Executive Reorganization Order (ERO) No. 41.

Background

ERO No. 41 was issued by Governor Sam Brownback on July 1, 2012. The ERO changed the name of the Department of Aging to the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and changed the name of the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services (SRS) to the Kansas Department for Children and Families (DCF). The ERO also transferred or consolidated certain services within these departments and the Department of Health and Environment.

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare.

To the Senate Committee on Judiciary, a KDADS representative submitted written testimony supporting the bill. No neutral or opponent testimony was submitted to the Senate Committee.

The Senate Committee made an additional technical amendment suggested by KDADS.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, the bill would have no fiscal effect.
