# SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 4

#### As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

# Brief\*

SB 4 would establish the Office of Information Technology Services (OITS) as a separate state agency for budgetary purposes. The OITS budget would be submitted separately from the Department of Administration budget.

# Background

The Legislative Post Auditor testified neutrally to the bill. He indicated OITS has little oversight over its rate structure and the proposed bill would allow the Legislature to inspect more closely and limit the agency expenditures.

No proponents or opponents testified.

OITS is included within the off-budget portion of the Department of Administration budget but the Department of Administration does not exercise operational control of the program.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget for the bill, as introduced, indicates there would be no fiscal effect to the state budget.
