SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 8

As Amended by Senate Committee on Education

Brief*

SB 8 would repeal the law establishing a school district audit team within the Legislative Division of Post Audit (LPA) and requiring the LPA to conduct performance audits and monitor school district funding and other oversight issues through audit work, as directed by the 2010 Commission.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Legislative Post Audit Committee. In the Senate Education Committee, a representative of the LPA appeared in support of the bill and explained the statute creating the 2010 Commission has expired, and the bill would repeal these outdated statutes.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to include a cross reference to one of the statutes elsewhere in the law, indicating it would be repealed.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
