2016 Kansas Statutes

- 21-5421. Terrorism. (a) Terrorism is the commission of, the attempt to commit, the conspiracy to commit, or the criminal solicitation to commit any felony with the intent to:
- (1) Intimidate or coerce the civilian population;
- (2) influence government policy by intimidation or coercion; or
- (3) affect the operation of any unit of government.
- (b) Terrorism or attempt, conspiracy or criminal solicitation to commit terrorism is an off-grid person felony.
- (c) The provisions of subsection (c) of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5301, and amendments thereto, shall not apply to a violation of attempting to commit the crime of terrorism pursuant to this section. The provisions of subsection (c) of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5302, and amendments thereto, shall not apply to a violation of conspiracy to commit the crime of terrorism pursuant to this section. The provisions of subsection (d) of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5303, and amendments thereto, shall not apply to a violation of criminal solicitation to commit the crime of terrorism pursuant to this section.
