**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: **SB166, exempting Cleveland University-Kansas City from the Private and Out-of-state Postsecondary Educational Institution Act.**

The Kansas Private and Out-of-state Postsecondary Educational Institution Act requires private and out-of-state institutions that wish to operate in Kansas to get a certificate of approval from the Kansas Board of Regents. That certificate must be renewed annually.

Senate Bill 166 would amend K.S.A. 74-32,164 by exempting Cleveland University-Kansas City from the Kansas Private and Out-of-state Postsecondary Educational Institution Act.

The bill would be effective upon publication in the statute book, July 1, 2017.
