My name is Wendy Coley, a resident of Sedgwick County where one of the three greyhound racing tracks is located.

I have been considering this matter for some time and have done some research on how this type of activity effects our community and the animals that will be used at our expense. I think it is time to consider who we are as a state and as a people. What are we willing to do for revenue and is it worth it? I believe the answer is "NO".

Did you know that many states that have legalized greyhound racing have lost more money than it brought in? In fact, in the state of Florida lost between \$1 million and \$3.3 million in 2012?
