My name is Lauren Peterson and I am a proud resident of Sedgwick County. To learn of the reopening of a greyhound racing track is devastating news.

This issue is extremely important to me as I spend much of my time trying to educate my middle school students about animal rescue and how we can all make a difference. I speak for many young children, young adults and other educators when I say - WE DO NOT WANT GREYHOUND RACING to return to Sedgwick County!

My students have found their passion for helping animals and being a voice for the voiceless; I fear that news of a new greyhound track would be a huge step in the wrong direction.
