Because Sedgwick County's referendum in August 2007 saw voters reject a casino and slot machines at the dog track, gaming companies applied for the Administrative Assistant management contract for projects costing a minimum of \$225 million plus a \$25 million privilege fee. The winning project was the Kansas Star Casino which Josly Heersche Receptionist relied on the observance of the Sedgwick County decision against casino gaming for its initial decision to apply and later to invest \$330 million in Sumner County
