 Re: Insurance Related License and Vehicle Registration Suspensions Due to Vehicle Insurance Coverage Issues by the Division of Vehicles

Good Afternoon Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to present written testimony on behalf of the Kansas Division of Vehicles. The following tables summarize action taken by the Division to suspend driver's licenses (All 3 tables) and vehicle registrations (Table 3 only) for CY 2011 through 2016. The data is a record of action taken and many of these suspensions/withdrawals may have been subsequently resolved. These numbers can include an individual multiple times due to different occurrences. At a higher level, the Division has 3,237,146 driver records (applied for or created) and 212,335 of them are suspended. (many of the suspensions are out of state drivers – and are not specific to insurance issues) Any additional questions? email to: ted.smith@ks.gov.
