SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2055 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2055 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2055 would amend the Pharmacy Practice Act to comply with federal law. The changes would include:

- 1. The update of categories of licensure to include third-party logistics provider, wholesale distributor, repackager, and outsourcing facility;
- 2. Provisions to assure compliance with the federal Drug Supply Chain Security Act;
- 3. Regulations for automated dispensing and compounding practices;
- 4. Licensee requirements to provide current contact information to the Board;
- 5. Clarification of circumstances and actions affecting license approval, denial, and discipline;
- 6. New requirements for pharmacy technician registrants; and,
- 7. Technical corrections to the Act.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates that the bill would not affect agency revenue or expenditures.
