SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2542 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2542 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2542 would amend the Kansas Private and Out-of-State Postsecondary Educational Institution Act by modifying or eliminating certain fees assessed to independent educational institutions chartered, incorporated or otherwise organized under the laws of Kansas and having their principal place of business in Kansas. The bill would also eliminate a sunset date of June 30, 2018, so that the Board may continue charging fees to these institutions indefinitely.

The Kansas Board of Regents estimates the enactment of HB 2542 would reduce annual fee revenues by \$3,870 beginning in FY 2019. The Board office uses these revenues to cover the costs incurred to regulate private and out-of-state postsecondary educational institutions. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2542 is not reflected in *The FY 2019 Governor's Budget Report*.
