SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2782 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2782 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, seized weapons and ammunition forfeited to a law enforcement agency that are no longer required as evidence may be used within the agency, sold to a Federal Firearms Dealer, or traded to a Federal Firearms Dealer for new or used firearms or accessories. HB 2782 would also permit the law enforcement agency to destroy the forfeited weapons and ammunition.

The Office of Judicial Administration, Kansas Bureau of Investigation, Kansas Highway Patrol, League of Kansas Municipalities, and Kansas Association of Counties indicate the enactment of HB 2782 would have no fiscal effect.
