SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 268 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 268 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 268 would allow the Insurance Commissioner to have access to expunged criminal history records to determine the qualifications to be an employee of or for licensure as an agent of the Insurance Department or the Office of Securities Commissioner. This provision would apply to all applications for employment and licensure on and after July 1, 2018.

The Insurance Department indicates SB 268 would have no fiscal effect. The Kansas Bureau of Investigations (KBI) indicates the bill would require certain criminal history record checks to include expunged records. However, the KBI does not anticipate any additional expenditures or collect any additional revenue because of this requirement.
