SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 319 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 319 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 319 would allow children who have attained the age of eligibility for school attendance and who have been placed by the Department for Children and Families or a court of competent jurisdiction into the care and physical custody of a foster care contractor; or who is being provided respite care, to attend school in the school district where the foster care contractor provides services. The bill also makes several changes and additions to definitions.

The Department for Children and Families and the Department of Education indicate enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
