SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 405 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 405 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 405 would establish an animal unit conversion factor of .003 for both broilers and laying hens for poultry facilities using dry manure systems. SB 405 would also require chicken facilities to have a federal permit if 125,000 or more broilers or 82,000 laying hens are confined.

According to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, enactment of SB 405 would have no fiscal effect.
