SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 93 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 93 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires the Division of Vehicles to revoke a person's driving privileges upon conviction of certain offenses identified in KSA 8-254. SB 93 would institute a 90-day revocation for these convictions.

The Department of Revenue indicates SB 93 would increase its expenditures in FY 2018 by \$1,162.50, including \$962.50 to revise KanDrive design documentation and development application code, and \$200 to conduct testing. The Office of Judicial Administration indicates any fiscal effect resulting from this bill would be negligible. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 93 is not reflected in *The FY 2018 Governor's Budget Report*.
