AN ACT concerning the Kansas family law code; relating to marriage; common-law marriage; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 23-2502 and 23-2714 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 23-2502 is hereby amended to read as follows: 23-2502. The state of Kansas shall not recognize a common-law marriage contract if either party to the marriage contract is under 18 years of age entered into after July 1, 2017.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 23-2714 is hereby amended to read as follows: 23-2714. (a) *Admissions*. Upon the trial of the action, the court may admit proof of the admissions of the parties to be received in evidence, excluding such as shall appear to have been obtained by connivance, fraud, coercion, or other improper means.
- (b) Marriage. Testimony admissible to prove a common-law marriage contract entered into prior to July 1, 2017, may be received as evidence of the marriage of the parties.
- (c) *Husband and wife as witness*. Either party to the action shall be competent to testify upon all material matters involved in the controversy.
- (d) *Corroborating testimony*. A decree of divorce, separate maintenance or annulment may be granted upon the uncorroborated testimony of either party or both of them.
- 23 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 23-2502 and 23-2714 are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
