## HOUSE BILL No. 2170

AN ACT concerning bicycles; relating to safety equipment; lamps and reflectors; amending K.S.A. 8-1592 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1592 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1592. (a) Every bicycle when in use\_at\_nighttime {between sunrise and sunset} shall be equipped with a lamp on the front which shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least\_five hundred (500) feet to the front and\_with either: (1) A red reflector on the rear\_of a type approved by the secretary of transportation which shall be visible from all distances from\_one hundred (100) feet to\_six\_hundred (600) feet to the rear when directly in front of lawful lower beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle-; or (2) a lamp on the rear\_emitting {that shall emit} a red light visible from a distance of five hundred (500) feet to the rear\_may be used in addition to the red reflector; or (3) the operator of such bicycle shall be wearing elothing {a device} that emits {a red or amber} light that shall be visible at {from} a distance of 500 feet to the rear.

- (b) Every bicycle shall be equipped with a brake which will enable the operator to make the braked wheels skid on dry, level, clean pavement.
- (c) No person shall sell a pedal for use on a bicycle, unless such pedal is equipped with a reflector<u>of a type approved by the secretary of transportation</u> which is visible from the front and rear of the bicycle to which it is attached during darkness from a distance of two hundred (200) feet, and no person shall sell a new bicycle, unless it is equipped with pedals meeting the requirements of this subsection.
  - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1592 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
