Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. (a) No court may require or order a witness who is alleged to be the victim of an offense described in article 55 of chapter 21 of the

to be the victim of an offense described in article 55 of chapter 21 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-6419 through 21-6422, and amendments thereto, human trafficking or aggravated human trafficking as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5426, and amendments thereto, or incest or aggravated incest as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5604, and amendments thereto, to submit to or undergo either a psychiatric or psychological examination.

- (b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas code of criminal procedure.
- 15 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
