AN ACT concerning advanced telecommunications services; authorizing the use of dark fiber.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Dark fiber that is owned or operated by the state or a local government shall be leased by such state or local government to any private sector broadband provider on a cost-plus basis upon request from such private sector broadband provider. The state or local government may retain enough dark fiber for reasonably anticipated 50-year fiber needs and shall not be required to enter into any lease agreement that impinges upon such needs.

- (b) The terms of any lease entered into pursuant to this section may be determined by auction or by negotiations between the state or local government and a private sector broadband provider.
 - (c) As used in this section:
- (1) "Cost-plus basis" means the prorated cost to install the fiber and any relevant supporting equipment plus a reasonable lease payment for the use of the fiber.
- (2) "Dark fiber" means fiber within an existing fiber optic cable that has not yet been activated through optronics to render it capable of carrying communications services.
- (3) "Local government" means any city, county or township located within the state of Kansas.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
