AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the operation of a motor vehicle;
 providing penalties for the use of a wireless communication device;
 amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-15,111 and 8-2118 and repealing the
 existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-15,111 is hereby amended to read as8 follows: 8-15,111. (a) As used in this section:

9 (1) "Wireless communication device" means any wireless electronic 10 communication device that provides for voice or data communication 11 between two or more parties, including, but not limited to, a mobile or 12 cellular telephone, a text messaging device, a personal digital assistant that 13 sends or receives messages, an audio-video player that sends or receives messages or a laptop computer. "Wireless communication device" does not 14 include a device which is voice-operated and which allows the user to send 15 16 or receive a text based communication without the use of either hand, except to activate or deactivate a feature or function. 17

(2) "Write, send or read a written communication" means using a
 wireless communication device to manually type, send or read a written
 communication, including, but not limited to, a text message, instant
 message or electronic mail.

(b) Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d), no person shall operate a motor vehicle on a public road or highway while: (1) Holding a wireless communication device to the person's ear; or (2) using a wireless communications device to write, send or read a written communication.

(c) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not apply to:

(1) A law enforcement officer or emergency service personnel acting
within the course and scope of the law enforcement officer's or emergency
service personnel's employment;

30 (2) a motor vehicle stopped off the regular traveled portion of the 31 roadway;

(3) a person who reads, selects or enters a telephone number or name
 in a wireless communications device for the purpose of making or
 receiving a phone call;

35 (4) a person who receives an emergency, traffic or weather alert36 message; or

1 (5) a person receiving a message related to the operation or 2 navigation of the motor vehicle.

3 (d) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not prohibit a person from using a wireless communications device while operating a moving motor 4 5 vehicle to.

6 7 (1) Report current or ongoing illegal activity to law enforcement; (2) prevent imminent injury to a person or property; or

8 (3) relay information between transit or for-hire operator and the 9 operator's dispatcher, in which the device is permanently affixed to the 10 motor vehicle; or

(4) summon medical or other emergency assistance.

(e) From and after the effective date of this act and prior to January 1, 12 2011, a law enforcement officer shall issue a warning eitation to anyone 13 violating subsection (b). 14

(f)—This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act 15 16 regulating traffic on highways.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as 17 18 follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except 19 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the 20 notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, 21 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified 22 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be 23 taxed as provided by law.

24 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 25 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as 26 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 27 28 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the 29 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in 30 31 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment 32 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 33 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 34 to trial and plea of no contest.

35 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly 36 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed 37 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose 38 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of 39 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference 40 only and is not a legal definition.

(d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
contained in subsection (c).

10 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 11 (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is 12 defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations 13 adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed 14 within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and 15 amendments thereto.

16 For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and (f)17 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-18 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction 19 shall be fined $1\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of 20 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 21 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 22 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 23 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be 24 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the 25 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 26 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 27 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 28 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 29 conviction shall be fined $2\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not 30 both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 31 subsection (c).

32 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 33 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a 34 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school 35 zone authorized under-subsection (a)(4) of K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and 36 amendments thereto.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-15,111 and 8-2118 are hereby repealed.
