SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2426

As Amended by House Committee on Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2426 would reconcile amendments to statutes that were amended more than once during the current and prior legislative sessions. For such statutes, the bill would repeal one version and amend the continuing version with non-contradictory amendments from the repealed version, creating a single version of the statute containing all amendments. [Note: One of the conflicts addressed by the bill would not require amendment of the continuing statute but only repeal of the conflicting version.]

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Appropriations. The Office of Revisor of Statutes submits a bill of this type annually to reconcile conflicting statutes. The House Committee amended the bill to reconcile additional statutes.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
