SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 135

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 135 would allow driver's license examiners within the Kansas Department of Revenue (KDOR) to have the choice to move from the classified to unclassified service.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs. In the Senate Committee hearing, a representative of the Division of Vehicles, KDOR, testified in favor of the bill, stating driver's license examiners were overlooked when a bill was passed in 2016 to allow other KDOR employees to move from the classified to unclassified service.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on KDOR operations.
