SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 353

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 353 would abolish the Boiler Inspection Fee Fund, and transfer all liabilities and any balance within this fund to the Fire Marshal Fee Fund of the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

Background

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means at the request of Senator Goddard (requested on behalf of the State Fire Marshal). In the Senate Committee hearing, the State Fire Marshal testified as a proponent of the bill.

No opponent or neutral testimony was provided.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget on the bill, the Office of the State Fire Marshal indicated the bill would have no fiscal effect.
