Senator Donovan recalled that the 2000 Legislature passed a sales tax exemption for the Kansas Academy of Sciences. Senator Donovan moved to introduce a bill making the sales tax exemption for the Kansas Academy of Sciences retroactive to 1992, seconded by Senator Praeger. The motion carried.
