Subject: HB 2140; Allowing agents of the KBI to participate in the Kansas DROP act

and extending the sunset date for the act.

House Bill No. 2140 adds agents of the Kansas bureau of investigation to the definition of "member" in the Kansas deferred retirement option program act or DROP. Under current law the only members of DROP are troopers, examiners and officers of the Kansas highway patrol.

The bill also extends the sunset date of the DROP act from January 1, 2020, to January 1, 2025.
