Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2162

HB 2162 amends definitions of “consumer transaction” and “supplier” in the Kansas consumer protection act.

The bill amends the definition of “consumer transaction” to exclude the disposition of repossessed collateral by a supplier that is compliant with state and federal law with respect to the disposition of the repossessed collateral.

It also amends the definition of “supplier” to remove the provision excluding banks, trust companies and lending institutions.
