• Regarding the 38, 277 referrals to CCBHCs from law enforcement in Missouri, was this number the total number of referrals from 2017-2019? Also, please provide an age breakdown on the 38, 277 referrals from law enforcement in Missouri.

Yes. Those are the total statewide referrals from 2017-2019. Most all of those referrals are adults, but when our data analyst gets back from vacation we can check with him and get a breakdown by age category.

• Are the CCBHC quality measures on page 12 of your presentation tracked by person or is aggregated measures?

Those measures are tracked in our population health tool in aggregate, and can be drilled down to an individual level for front line staff to be able to have the appropriate interventions to address and improve with their population.
