# Round 2 SPARK/CARES Dollars to CMHCs

- KDADS requested \$12,500,000 of the SPARK/CARES dollars for Behavioral Health stakeholders as part of Round 2 projects in June.
  - Of the \$12.5 million, \$7.5 million was provided to the 26 Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs), via fully executed grants in October.
    - Since October, two additional transfers totaling \$6.7 million (\$5.2 + \$1.5) of the Round 2 dollars has been provided to 20 of the 26 CMHCs, via amended grants.
      - A total of \$14.2 million has been provided to the CMHCs.
