TESTIMONY ON HB 2426 Before the Judiciary Committee of the Kansas Senate

February 17, 2020

Chairman Wilborn and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on one of the most significant bills that this committee will consider today.

I am happy to place my name on this legislation for two compelling reasons.
