







UNDUPLICATED PATIENTS AND VISITS






Insurance Status, Patients Served in 2018

School-based Services


- 15 clinics

 - Primary and preventive care
 - Dental and oral health services
 - Behavioral health services
- Care at all levels
 - 100% provide care in elementary schools
 - 92% provide care in middle schools
 - 85% provide care in high schools

The Value in Value-based Care

Community Clinics provide care to FOUR patients for ONE YEAR for far less than what it costs for ONE VISIT to an Emergency Room.

Community Care Clinic: \$382/patient/year Emergency Room Visit: \$1,423
