**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2158 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2158 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2158 would authorize the Kansas Board of Regents to sell certain real property in Douglas County on behalf of the University of Kansas.

The University of Kansas indicates HB 2158 would eliminate costs for maintenance as the building is in poor condition and the cost of renewal is nearly half the replacement value. The University indicates one-time revenues from the sale would be remitted to the Restricted Fees Fund and applied to deferred maintenance. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2158 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
