**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2168 by House Committee on Higher Education Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2168 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2168 would authorize the Kansas Board of Regents to sell certain real property in Cherokee County and Riley County on behalf of Kansas State University.

Kansas State University indicates the costs associated with obtaining appraisals would be negligible and could be absorbed within existing resources. The University indicates revenues from the sale would be remitted to the Restricted Fees Fund. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2168 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
