SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2690 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2690 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2690 would amend the Student Data Privacy Act. The bill would require that a student, if an adult, or the parent or guardian of the student, if the student is a minor, is to be provided a copy of a test, questionnaire, survey or examination that would include any questions about personal beliefs prior to giving written consent to take the test, questionnaire, survey or examination.

According to the Department of Education, the enactment of HB 2690 would have no fiscal effect.
