SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 325 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 325 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 325 would add certain business entities to the definition of “health care provider” in the Health Care Provider Insurance Availability Act regarding healthcare provider insurance and would require that these certain entities be Kansas corporations in order to participate in the Health Care Stabilization Fund.

The Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund states that other than answering additional provider questions regarding the requirements, it is unclear how enactment of SB 325 might affect the Fund. The Board of Healing Arts states that no additional expenditures should result from enactment of the bill and states that any additional revenue resulting from the provisions of the bill would be negligible.
