AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to electric-assisted scooters; 1 2 definitions; requirements; penalty; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-126, 8-128<del>, 8-197</del>, 8-1486 and 8-2118 and repealing the existing sections. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: New Section 1. "Electric-assisted scooter" means every self-propelled 6 7 vehicle that has at least two wheels in contact with the ground, an electric motor, handlebars, a brake and a deck that is designed to be stood upon 8 9 when riding. 10 New Sec. 2. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate an 11 electric-assisted scooter: (1) on any interstate highway, federal highway or 12 state highway; or (2) on any public highway or street within the corporate 13 limits of any city unless authorized by such city. 14 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), traffic regulations applicable to bicycles shall apply to electric-assisted 15 16 scooters. (c) The governing body of a city or county may adopt an 17 18 ordinance that further restricts or prohibits the operation of electric-19 assisted scooters on any public highway, street or sidewalk within such 20 city or county. 21 (d) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c), the provisions 22 of subsection (a) shall not prohibit an electric-assisted scooter from 23 crossing a federal or state highway. 24 (e) (e) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the uniform 25 act regulating traffic on highways. 26 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-126 is hereby amended to read as 27 follows: 8-126. The following words and phrases when used in this act 28 shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them herein: 29 (a) "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized nonhighway vehicle 50 30 inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 1,500 pounds or less, 31 traveling on three or more nonhighway tires. (b) "Autocycle" means a three-wheel motorcycle that has a steering 32 wheel and seating that does not require the operator to straddle or sit 33 34 astride it. "Commission" or "state highway commission" means the director 35 (c) 36 of vehicles of the department of revenue.

1 (d) "Contractor" means a person, partnership, corporation, local 2 government, county government, county treasurer or other state agency 3 that has contracted with the department to provide services associated with 4 vehicle functions.

5 (e) "Department" or "motor vehicle department" or "vehicle 6 department" means the division of vehicles of the department of revenue, 7 acting directly or through its duly authorized officers and agents. When 8 acting on behalf of the department of revenue pursuant to this act, a county 9 treasurer shall be deemed to be an agent of the state of Kansas.

10 (f) "Division" means the division of vehicles of the department of 11 revenue.

12 (g) "Electric-assisted scooter" means every self-propelled vehicle 13 that has at least two wheels in contact with the ground, an electric motor, 14 handlebars, a brake and a deck that is designed to be stood upon when 15 riding.

16 (g)(h) "Electric personal assistive mobility device" means a selfbalancing two nontandem wheeled device, designed to transport only one person, with an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed of the device to 15 miles per hour or less.

20 (h)(i) "Electric vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered by an 21 electric motor drawing current from rechargeable storage batteries or other 22 portable electrical energy storage devices, provided the recharge energy 23 must be drawn from a source off the vehicle, such as, but not limited to:

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(1) Residential electric service;

(2) an electric vehicle charging station, also called an EV charging
station, an electric recharging point, a charging point, EVSE (Electric
Vehicle Supply Equipment) or a public charging station.

28 (i)(j) "Electronic certificate of title" means any electronic record of 29 ownership, including any lien or liens that may be recorded, retained by 30 the division in accordance with K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-135d, and 31 amendments thereto.

32 (j)(k) "Electronic notice of security interest" means the division's 33 online internet program-which *that* enables a dealer or secured party to 34 submit a notice of security interest as defined in this section, and to cancel 35 the notice or release the security interest using the program. This program 36 is also known as the Kansas elien or KSelien.

 $\begin{array}{ll} 37 & (k)(l) & \text{"Farm tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used as} \\ 38 & a farm implement power unit operated with or without other attached farm \\ 39 & implements in any manner consistent with the structural design of such \\ 40 & power unit. \end{array}$ 

41 (1)(m) "Farm trailer" means every trailer and semitrailer as those 42 terms are defined in this section, designed and used primarily as a farm 43 vehicle.

(m)(n) "Foreign vehicle" means every motor vehicle, trailer, or 1 2 semitrailer-which that shall be brought into this state otherwise than in 3 ordinary course of business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and 4 which has not been registered in this state.

5 (n)(o) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three 6 wheels in contact with the ground, an unladen weight of not more than 7 1,800 pounds, is designed to be and is operated at not more than 25 miles 8 per hour and is designed to carry not more than four persons including the 9 driver

10  $(\mathbf{o})(p)$  "Highway" means every way or place of whatever nature open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular 11 travel. The term "highway" shall not be deemed to include a roadway or 12 13 driveway upon grounds owned by private owners, colleges, universities or 14 other institutions

15  $(\mathbf{p})(q)$  "Implement of husbandry" means every vehicle designed or 16 adapted and used exclusively for agricultural operations, including 17 feedlots, and only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways. 18 Such term shall include, but not be limited to:

19 (1) A farm tractor:

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(2) a self-propelled farm implement;

21 (3) a fertilizer spreader, nurse tank or truck permanently mounted 22 with a spreader used exclusively for dispensing or spreading water, dust or 23 liquid fertilizers or agricultural chemicals, as defined in K.S.A. 2-2202, 24 and amendments thereto, regardless of ownership;

25 (4) a truck mounted with a fertilizer spreader used or manufactured 26 principally to spread animal dung:

27 (5) a mixer-feed truck owned and used by a feedlot, as defined in 28 K.S.A. 47-1501, and amendments thereto, and specially designed and used 29 exclusively for dispensing food to livestock in such feedlot. 30

"Lien" means a security interest as defined in this section.  $\left( \mathbf{q} \right) (r)$ 

31 "Lightweight roadable vehicle" means a multipurpose motor <del>(r)</del>(s) 32 vehicle that is allowed to be driven on public roadways and is required to 33 be registered with, and flown under the direction of, the federal aviation 34 administration.

35 "Manufacturer" means every person engaged in the business of (s)(t)36 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

37 "Micro utility truck" means any motor vehicle-which that is not (t)(u)38 less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, 39 of not more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and 40 fluids, of more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as 41 originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. "Micro 42 utility truck" does not include a work-site utility vehicle or recreational 43 off-highway vehicle.

1 (u)(v) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle, other than a motorized 2 bicycle or a motorized wheelchair, which *that* is self-propelled.

3 (v)(w) "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle, including 4 autocycles, designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact 5 with the ground, except any such vehicle as may be included within the 6 term "tractor" as defined in this section.

7 (w)(x) "Motorized bicycle" means every device having two tandem 8 wheels or three wheels, which that may be propelled by either human 9 power or helper motor, or by both, and which has:

(1) A motor which produces not more than 3.5 brake horsepower;

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(2) a cylinder capacity of not more than 130 cubic centimeters;

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(3) an automatic transmission; and

13 (4) the capability of a maximum design speed of no more than 3014 miles per hour.

15 (x)(y) "Motorized wheelchair" means any self-propelled vehicle 16 designed specifically for use by a physically disabled person and such 17 vehicle is incapable of a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour.

18 (y)(z) "New vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in 19 the business of buying, selling or exchanging new motor vehicles, travel 20 trailers, trailers or vehicles and who holds a dealer's contract therefor from 21 a manufacturer or distributor and who has an established place of business 22 in this state.

23 (z)(aa) "Nonresident" means every person who is not a resident of 24 this state.

25 (aa)(bb) "Notice of security interest" means a notification to the division from a dealer or secured party of a purchase money security 26 interest as provided in article 9 of chapter 84 of the Kansas Statutes 27 28 Annotated, and amendments thereto, upon a vehicle-which that has been 29 sold and delivered to the purchaser describing the vehicle and showing the 30 name, address and acknowledgment of the secured party as well as the 31 name and address of the debtor or debtors and other information the 32 division requires.

33 (bb)(cc) "Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling 34 machinery or equipment" means a vehicle constructed as a machine used exclusively for servicing, cleaning-out or drilling an oil well and 35 36 consisting in general of a mast, an engine for power, a draw works and a 37 chassis permanently constructed or assembled for one or more of those 38 purposes. The passenger capacity of the cab of a vehicle shall not be 39 considered in determining whether such vehicle is oil well servicing, oil 40 well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery or equipment.

41 (ee)(dd) "Owner" means a person who holds the legal title of a 42 vehicle, or in the event a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the 43 conditional sale thereof with the right of purchase upon performance of the 1 conditions stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of 2 possession vested in the conditional vendee or in the event a vehicle is 3 subject to a lease of 30 days or more with an immediate right of possession 4 vested in the lessee; or in the event a party having a security interest in a 5 vehicle is entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee or lessee or 6 secured party shall be deemed the owner for the purpose of this act.

7 (dd)(ee) "Passenger vehicle" means every motor vehicle, as defined 8 in this section, which that is designed primarily to carry 10 or fewer 9 passengers, and which is not used as a truck.

(ce)(ff) "Person" means every natural person, firm, partnership,
 association or corporation.

12 (ff)(gg) "Pole trailer" means any two-wheel vehicle used as a trailer 13 with bolsters that support the load, and do not have a rack or body 14 extending to the tractor drawing the load.

(gg)(hh) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means any motor vehicle
 more than 50 but not greater than 64 inches in width, having a dry weight
 of 2,000 pounds or less, traveling on four or more nonhighway tires.

(hh)(ii) "Road tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used
 for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry any load
 thereon independently, or any part of the weight of a vehicle or load so
 drawn.

(ii)(jj) "Self-propelled farm implement" means every farm implement
 designed for specific use applications with its motive power unit
 permanently incorporated in its structural design.

25 (ij)(kk) "Semitrailer" means every vehicle of the trailer type so 26 designed and used in conjunction with a motor vehicle that some part of its 27 own weight and that of its own load rests upon or is carried by another 28 vehicle.

(kk)(*ll*) "Specially constructed vehicle" means any vehicle which *that*shall not have been originally constructed under a distinctive name, make,
model or type, or which *that*, if originally otherwise constructed shall have
been materially altered by the removal of essential parts, or by the addition
or substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other vehicles
or makes of vehicles.

(11)(mm) "Trailer" means every vehicle without motive power
 designed to carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and
 to be drawn by a motor vehicle.

(mm)(nn) "Travel trailer" means every vehicle without motive power
 designed to be towed by a motor vehicle constructed primarily for
 recreational purposes.

41 (nn)(oo) "Truck" means a motor vehicle which that is used for the
 42 transportation or delivery of freight and merchandise or more than 10
 43 passengers.

1  $(\cos)(pp)$  "Truck tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and 2 used primarily for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to 3 carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle or load so drawn.

4 (pp)(qq) "Used vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged 5 in the business of buying, selling or exchanging used vehicles, and having 6 an established place of business in this state and who does not hold a 7 dealer's contract for the sale of new motor vehicles, travel trailers or 8 vehicles.

9 (qq)(rr) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which any
 10 person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a public
 11 highway, excepting electric personal assistive mobility devices or devices
 12 moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

(rr)(ss) "Vehicle functions" means services relating to the application, 13 processing, auditing or distribution of original or renewal vehicle 14 15 registrations, certificates of title, driver's licenses and division-issued 16 identification cards associated with services and functions set out in articles 1, 2 and 13 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and 17 18 amendments thereto. "Vehicle functions" may also include personal 19 property taxation duties set out in article 51 of chapter 79 of the Kansas 20 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, and other vehicle-related 21 events described in article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, 22 and amendments thereto.

23 (ss)(tt) "Work-site utility vehicle" means any motor vehicle-whichthat is not less than 48 inches in width, has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of more than 800 pounds and is equipped with four or more nonhighway tires, a steering wheel and bench or bucket-type seating allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side, and may be equipped with a bed or cargo box for hauling materials. "Work-site utility vehicle" does not include a micro utility truck or recreational off-highway vehicle.

30 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-128 is hereby amended to read as 31 follows: 8-128. (a) The following need not be registered under this act, 32 any:

- 33 (1) Implement of husbandry;
- 34 (2) all-terrain vehicle;
- 35 (3) micro utility truck;
- 36 (4) golf cart;

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37 (5) work-site utility vehicle;

(6) road roller or road machinery temporarily operated or movedupon the highways;

- (7) municipally owned fire truck;
- 41 (8) privately owned fire truck subject to a mutual aid agreement with 42 a municipality;
- 43 (9) school bus owned and operated by a school district or a nonpublic

school-which *that* has the name of the municipality, school district or
 nonpublic school plainly painted thereon;

(10) farm trailer used in carrying not more than 6,000 pounds owned 3 4 by a person engaged in farming, which trailer is used exclusively by the 5 owner to transport agricultural products produced by such owner or 6 commodities purchased by the owner for use on the farm owned or rented 7 by the owner of such trailer and the weight of any such farm trailer, plus 8 the cargo weight of 6,000 pounds or less, shall not be considered in 9 determining the gross weight for which the truck or truck tractor 10 propelling the same shall be registered; or

11 (11) farm trailer used and designed for transporting hay or forage 12 from a field to a storage area or from a storage area to a feedlot<del>, which</del> 13 *that* is only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways, except that 14 this paragraph shall not apply to a farm semitrailer; or

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(12) electric-assisted scooter.

16 (b) Self-propelled cranes where the crane operator on a job site 17 operates the controls of such crane from a permanent housing or module 18 on the crane and the crane is not used for the transportation of property, except the property that is required for the operation of the crane itself and 19 20 earth moving equipment which that are equipped with pneumatic tires may 21 be moved on the highways of this state from one job location to another, or 22 to or from places of storage, delivery or repair, without complying with the 23 provisions of the law relating to registration and display of license plates 24 but shall comply with all the other requirements of the law relating to 25 motor vehicles.

(c) Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery
or equipment need not be registered under this act but shall comply with
all the other requirements of the law relating to motor vehicles.

(d) A truck permanently mounted with a hydraulic concrete pump and placing boom may be moved on the highways of this state from one job location to another, or to or from places of storage delivery or repair, without being registered under this act, but shall comply with all the other requirements of the law relating to motor vehicles. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to ready-mix concrete trucks.

Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-197 is hereby amended to read asfollows: 8-197. (a) The provisions of K.S.A. 8-197 to *through* 8-199, inclusive, and amendments thereto, shall be a part of and supplemental to the provisions of article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, and as used in such sections, the words and phrases defined by K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them therein.

5 (ii) any motor vehicle, other than a salvage vehicle, for which the 6 owner has not provided motor vehicle liability insurance coverage or an 7 approved self insurance plan under K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments-8 thereto, and has not applied for or obtained registration of such motor 9 vehicle in accordance with article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes 10 Annotated, and amendments thereto;

(iii) any all-terrain vehicle; 11

12 (iv) any work-site utility vehicle;

13 (v) any micro utility truck;

(vi) recreational off-highway vehicle; or 14

(vii) any travel trailer which that cannot be registered because it is not 15 16 manufactured for the purpose of using the travel trailer on the highways of 17 this state and is not provided with the equipment by state statute for travel 18 trailers which that are used on the highways of this state; or

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(viii) any electric-assisted scooter; and

20 (B) "nonhighway vehicle" shall not include an implement of-21 husbandry, as defined in K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto. 22

(2) "Salvage vehicle" means:

23 (A) Any motor vehicle, other than a late model vehicle, which that is 24 of a type required to be registered in this state, but which *that* cannot be 25 registered because it has been wrecked or damaged to the extent that: The 26 equipment required by state statute on any such vehicle used on the-27 highways of this state is not present or is not in good condition or proper adjustment, as prescribed by state statute or any rules and regulations-28 29 adopted pursuant thereto, or such vehicle is in an inoperable condition or a 30 condition that would render the operation thereof on the highways of this 31 state a hazard to the public safety; and in either event, such vehicle would 32 require substantial repairs to rebuild or restore such vehicle to a condition 33 which that will permit the registration thereof;

34 (B) a late model vehicle which that is of a type required to be-35 registered in this state and which has been wrecked or damaged to the 36 extent that the total cost of repair is 75% or more of the fair market value 37 of the motor vehicle immediately preceding the time it was wrecked or-38 damaged and such condition was not merely exterior cosmetic damage to 39 such vehicle as a result of windstorm or hail;

40 (C) a motor vehicle, which *that* is of a type required to be registered in this state that the insurer determines is a total loss and for which the 41 42 insurer takes title: or

(D) a travel trailer which that is of a type required to be registered in 43

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this state, but which cannot be registered because it has been wreeked or

damaged to the extent that: (i) The equipment required by state statute on 2 3 any such travel trailer used on the highways of this state is not present or is 4 not in good condition or proper adjustment, as prescribed by state statute 5 or any rules and regulations; or (ii) such travel trailer is in an inoperable 6 condition or a condition that would render the operation on the highways 7 of this state a hazard to the public safety; and in either event, such travel 8 trailer would require substantial repairs to rebuild or restore to a condition 9 which that will permit the registration of the travel trailer; 10 (3) "salvage title" means a certificate of title issued by the divisiondesignating a motor vehicle or travel trailer a salvage vehicle; 11 12 (4) "rebuilt salvage vehicle" means any motor vehicle or travel trailer 13 previously issued a salvage title; (5) "rebuilt salvage title" means a certificate of title issued by the 14 division for a vehicle previously designated a salvage vehicle which that is 15 16 now designated a rebuilt salvage vehicle; 17 (6) "late model vehicle" means any motor vehicle which has a 18 manufacturer's model year designation of or later than the year in which 19 that the vehicle was wrecked or damaged or any of the six preceding-20 vears: 21 (7) "fair market value" means the retail value of a motor vehicle as: 22 (A) Set forth in a current edition of any nationally recognized-23 compilation, including an automated database of retail value; or 24 (B) determined pursuant to a market survey of comparable vehicles 25 with regard to condition and equipment; and (8) "cost of repairs" means the estimated or actual retail cost of parts 26 27 needed to repair a vehicle plus the cost of labor computed by using the 28 hourly labor rate and time allocations for automobile repairs that are-29 eustomary and reasonable. Retail costs of parts and labor rates may be 30 based upon collision estimating manuals or electronic computer estimating 31 systems customarily used in the automobile industry. The total cost of 32 repairs to rebuild or reconstruct the vehicle shall not include the cost of 33 repairing, replacing or reinstalling tires, sound systems, or any sales tax on 34 parts or materials to rebuild or reconstruct the vehicle. 35 Sec.-6. 5. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1486 is hereby amended to read as 36 follows: 8-1486. K.S.A. 8-1402a, 8-1414a, 8-1439c, 8-1458a, 8-1459a, 8-37 1475a, 8-1487, 8-1488, 8-1489 and 8-1490, and amendments thereto, and 38 K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1491, 8-1492, 8-1493, 8-1494, 8-1495, 8-1496-and, 39 8-1497 and section 1, and amendments thereto, shall be a part of, and 40 supplemental to, the uniform act regulating traffic on highways. Sec. 7. 6. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as 41 follows: 8-2118.(a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except 42

43 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the

notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial,
 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified
 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be
 taxed as provided by law.

5 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 6 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive 7 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as 8 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 9 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment 10 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in 11 12 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 13 14 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 15 to trial and plea of no contest.

16 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly 17 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine-which *that* may be imposed 18 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose 19 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of 20 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference 21 only and is not a legal definition.

(d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
contained in subsection (c).

(e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
(c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
amendments thereto.

(f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined  $1\frac{1}{2}$  times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection

(c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 1 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 2 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be 3 4 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the 5 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 6 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 7 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 8 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 9 conviction shall be fined  $2\frac{1}{2}$  times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 10 11 subsection (c).

12 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 13 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a 14 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school 15 zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

16 (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and 17 amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for 18 19 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior 20 21 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 22 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding 23 violation.
