1	AN ACT concerning legal public holidays; designating General Election
2	Day as a legal public holiday; amending K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 35-107 and
3	repealing the existing section.

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
6	Section 1. K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 35-107 is hereby amended to read as
7	follows: 35-107. (a) On and after January 1, 2006 2020, the following days
8	are declared to be legal public holidays and are to be observed as such:
9	New Year's Day, January 1;
10	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January;
11	President's Day, the third Monday in February;
12	Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
13	Independence Day, July 4;
14	Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
15	Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;
16	General Election Day, the first Tuesday after the first Monday in even-
17	numbered years in November;
18	Veterans' Day, the eleventh day in November;
19	Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
20	Christmas Day, December 25.
21	(b) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of
22	legal holidays shall on and after January 1,-2006 2020, be considered as a
23	reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the observance
24	of such legal holiday or holidays.
25	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 35-107 is hereby repealed.
26	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
27	publication in the statute book.
