Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) A city or county shall not prohibit, require a license, permit or fee or otherwise regulate the occasional sale of lemonade or other nonalcoholic beverages from a stand on private property or in a public park by an individual under 18 years of age.

- (b) A property owners' association of a residential subdivision shall not adopt or enforce a regulation or restrictive covenant that prohibits or otherwise regulates or requires a permit or fee regarding the occasional sale of lemonade or other nonalcoholic beverages from a stand on property in the subdivision by an individual under 18 years of age.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
