SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 433

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 433 would amend the Kansas Liquor Control Act and Club and Drinking Establishment Act by providing that violation of any lawful order issued by the Director (Director) of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) would be a reason the Director could suspend, involuntarily cancel, or revoke any license issued under those Acts.

Background

The bill was requested in the Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs at the request of the Division of ABC, Department of Revenue.

In the Senate Committee hearing, the Director provided proponent testimony, stating the bill would clarify and improve the procedures for enforcing administrative orders, would make the process easier to understand for licensees, and would make enforcement easier for staff of the ABC to track.

The Senate Committee recommended the bill be placed on the Consent Calendar.

A fiscal note was not available at the time the Senate Committee took action.
