Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee,

On behalf of the Wichita Regional Chamber of Commerce, thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony in support of H.B. 2101; AN ACT concerning the university engineering initiative act; relating to goals; authorizing transfers from the expanded lottery act revenues fund for certain fiscal years; amending K.S.A. 74-8768 and 76-7,137 and repealing the existing sections.

This legislation extends funding from the Expanded Lottery Act Revenue Fund for engineering programs at Kansas universities.
