() During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the above agency shall not expend any moneys appropriated from the state general fund or any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2022 by section 80 of chapter 98 of the 2021 Session Laws of Kansas, section 40 of chapter 116 of the 2021 Session Laws of Kansas, section 69 of 2022 House Substitute for Substitute for Senate Bill No. 267, this or any other appropriation act of the 2022 regular session of the legislature to impose any limitation on funding, including, but not limited to, a maximum amount that may be paid for services, for the prospective payment system established pursuant to K.S.A. 39-2019, and amendments thereto, under the medical assistance program for certified community behavioral health centers other than limitations imposed by the United States centers for medicare and medicaid services.
